Yoga & Meditation with

Japanese Paper Crafts

August 8-12, 2011

This one week program will offer students in grades 4 through 7 (ages 9-12) an opportunity to practice and learn beginning yoga postures along with meditation techniques. The class is designed for students and incorporates yoga games and a variety of poses, and meditation techniques that can improve concentration, confidence, a sense of calm, as well as strength, stamina, and flexibility. During the second hour, students will create Japanese Origami and Kirigami paper crafts. Origami is the art of paper folding, whereas, Kirigami is the art of paper cutting. Students will create several objects and pictures demonstrating the art forms.
